EASY DOES IT WEEKEND AT CAMP SEELY



FRONT WAY

There are two ways to get to Camp Seely from either the 10 or 210 freeway. To attempt the **front ascent**, go North on I-215 to the CA-259N toward CA-210E Highland Ave./Mountain Resorts exit-merge onto 210E. Take the CA-18 Waterman Ave. Exit. Turn left onto CA-18. Go up the mountain about 14 miles to the Crestline turnoff (CA-138). Make a sharp right turn then bear left following the signs to Valley of Enchantment. When you reach the fork in the road at Valley of Enchantment, bear to the right. Camp Seely is about ½ mile, on the left.

To go the **back way** up the mountain take I-15 (if coming from the West or North) or I-215 (if coming from the East) to the CA-138 Silverwood Lake/Wrightwood/Palmdale exit. Turn right towards Silverwood Lake and continue on for approximately 19 miles. Camp Seely is on your right – you will see the cabins through the trees as you approach. If you reach the town of Valley of Enchantment you've gone past the camp.
